Halifax's new ATM in Leventhorpe goes live

Following HBOS' previous announcement of its commitment to provide 100 new fee-free ATMs in low income areas across Scotland and Northern England, a new Halifax's ATM is now live and operational in Leventhorpe.

Located at Leventhorpe Post Office at 1009 Thornton Road, Bradford, BD8 0PA, the new fee-free through the wall ATM is located in an area where previously there were only surcharging machines.

Clarity

Each ATM will be clearly labeled to show that HBOS will not levy any charge for using the machine. HBOS was the first ATM provider to colour code its ATMs to inform customers that the ATMs provided free cash withdrawals.

Mahmud Nawaz who is leading the project for HBOS said,

"These new ATMs will help people in the area Leventhorpe and be available to use free of charge."
