Covid-19

In response to the ongoing Covid-19 situation in the UK, from 6 April 2020 credit card borrowers impacted financially by Covid-19 can request a payment holiday for up to three months with the option to extend for a further 3 months on expiry of the initial holiday. The payment holiday request initial deadline was 31 October 2020 and was subsequently extended to 31 March 2021. As at 31 December 2020 the trust included £35,429,709 (8,018 accounts) on active payment holidays. Customers on a payment holiday are not considered to be in a payment shortfall and as such will not be reported as delinquent. Payment holidays will reduce the revenue and principal received by the Trust, however, liquidity remains available through existing structural mechanisms and note principal payments are modest in the next 12 months.
