The programme launched on March 5th with the first cohort of 30 Lloyds Banking Group leaders participating in an intensive two-day session at the University of Cambridge. This included a session with Prof. Stelios Kavadias, a world leader in Innovation and Technology Management, setting the foundation for this ambitious professional development initiative.

The programme with Cambridge Spark will empower our business leaders to further innovate with Al and drive commercial excellence using this transformative technology.
